Data Flow





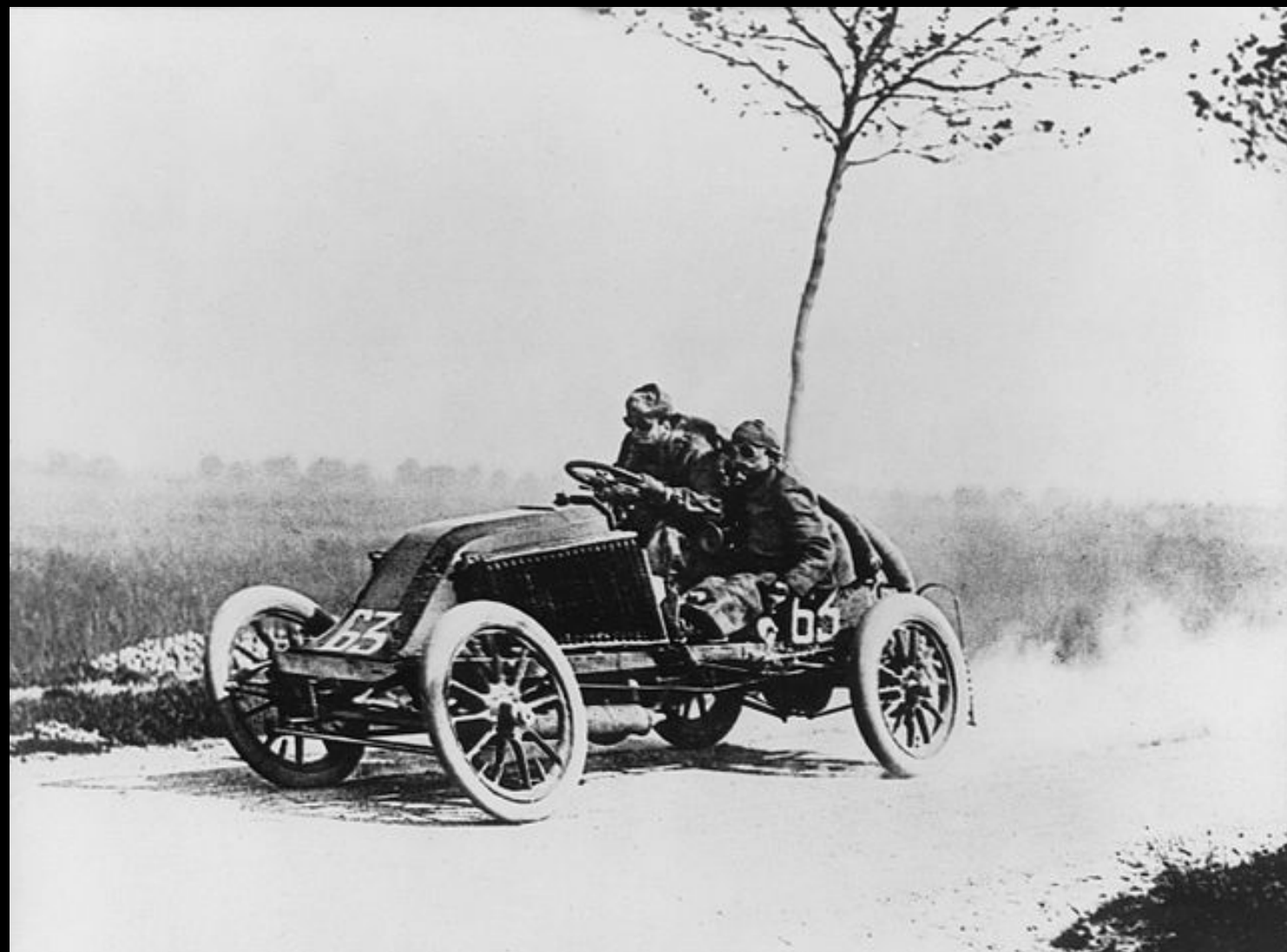
